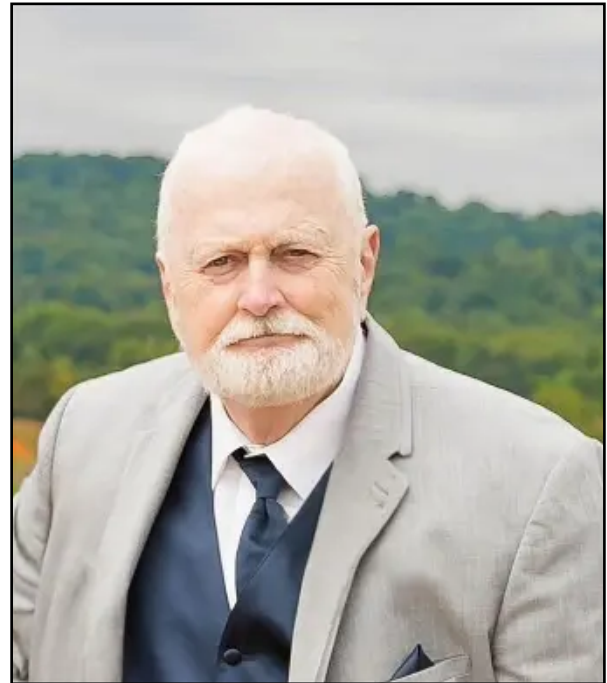


Stanley Wilson "Stan" Pangle Jr.
